

Group helps to place new minority teachers

Nearly 50 percent of new teachers placed in classrooms last year by the California Teacher Corps were members of underrepresented minority groups, the Corps reported.

One-quarter were Latino and 9 percent were African-American, according to the corps, which represents the state's alternative-certification programs.
